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Aaron Latto is Senior Vice President of Great American Insurance Group. He leads the property and casualty group's Corporate Claims function and is responsible for oversight of all U.S. and international claims operations including execution of claims strategy, philosophy and quality management. Within the Corporate Claims division are the following groups and operations: Claims Practices; Claims Support Services; Claims Business Intelligence & Technology; Claims Counsel; Special Investigations Unit; Claims Training & Development; Claims Litigation Services; Reinsurance Claims; Asbestos & Environmental Claims; and Claims Resolution Services. Aaron joined Great American in September 2010.

Previously, Aaron was a Vice President with Travelers Insurance. He managed the Business Torts Claim organization, which was responsible for claims involving intellectual property, advertising injury, technology E&O, cyber liability, and entertainment E&O matters. He advised internal business partners on litigation trends and legislative developments, and collaborated in strategic planning, new product development, training and marketing. Aaron began his Travelers career in March 2000, joining the organization as a Technology Claim Attorney. In June 2001, he joined Global Technology Underwriting. In Global Technology, Aaron held a number of positions including E-Commerce Underwriting Director, IT Segment Underwriting Director, and Director of Market Solutions. In these roles, Aaron worked on underwriting appetite and practices, over-authority submissions, specialty product development, and the creation and launch of an automated application and underwriting platform for technology companies with up to \$25 million in annual revenue.

Prior to joining Travelers, Aaron was a lawyer in private practice at the Zelle Hofmann Voelbel Mason & Gette LLP and Meagher & Geer PLLP law firms in Minneapolis, Minnesota. He concentrated his law practice in the defense of professional liability, products, and intellectual property matters, as well as the representation of insurers in coverage, bad faith, and premium disputes nationwide.
